LAST MEETING:

- 54 members attended.
- Lion Ed Hatton won the 50-50 and Lion Lyle Brockway won the special drawing.
- New members Lonny Sowers, Ken Brandon, and Vance Holowenko were installed by membership chairman Lion Denny Lumley. Welcome aboard!
- Lion JP Morgan was presented a Key Award for bringing in two new members.
- Lion Ray Goldbach of the building committee reported Lion Ken Brandon drew up plans for the roof project and Lion Bob Hutchinson knows an engineer that will stamp the drawings at no charge. This will allow us to obtain the necessary building permit. Funding has been approved and the membership voted to install a green roof.
- Lion Dave Volosin reported Thanksgiving baskets will be delivered this coming Saturday and Christmas baskets on December 17th. He will be working on bicycles once he knows how many he needs.
- Lion Tom Mowery reported Jamestown sold 345 Harley tickets making the club \$1,976. The winner was Chad Burton of Sagertown. Lion Tom still has KBA gun raffle tickets available and so far they haven't sold enough to pay for the guns.
- Sight Conservation chairman Lion Bob Moore reported the Eye Surgery Trust Fund approved our two applications. The membership approved \$1,200 to cover the remaining costs. Applications for sight assistance are way up throughout the District.

- Treasurer Bob Blake gave a final report on the fair projects and we had total profits of \$6,946.
- Several members reported on the District cabinet meeting: there is a new club in Corry, \$60K was donated by LCIF to Pennsylvania clubs for flood relief, there may be a small PA dues increase, and so far they do not have a second VP district candidate.

BOARD OF DIRECTORS:

- Approved \$150 to help sponsor the David Veverka basketball tipoff tournament.
- Discussion was held and a motion was made and seconded to change the numbers on the board of directors. Due to a lack of a quorum, directors were unable to vote on this or any further business.
